Our church has become a hub of activity as we are so well situated within the community.

- We are the site for the Downtown Community Garden, 3 raised garden plots, which accommodate the Little Sprouts gardening program (preschoolers), another plot for individuals who are responsible for the care of the garden and the third one for the Community Food Bank. This is all in coordination with the Local Food Initiative group.
- We also house the monthly Coffee House evening from October to April.
- During the winter months the Soup and a Smile Community Lunch Program has been up and running for 10 years and has become a great gathering place for many who are lonely in the community. It is safe place for them to meet up with others, eat together, and visit. Our minister also uses this time to meet and greet many he would not otherwise have contact with.
- The Community choir meets every week from September to May with two well attended performances. Many other groups are welcomed into our building from groups seeking overnight stays to businesses and service clubs looking for a central place to hold meetings or have a meal.
